

AAVP Young Investigator Travel Grants (YITG)

- Applicants must be a full-time graduate/undergraduate/DVM student enrolled in an accredited institution of higher learning or an individual who is within 3 years of their terminal degree (MS, PhD, or DVM).
- Only a person submitting an abstract and presenting an oral paper or poster at the annual meeting of the AAVP is eligible.
- The applicant must be a member of AAVP at the time of application.
- Funds must be applied to travel to the AAVP meeting held during the year of application. The applicant must be sponsored by an active full member of the AAVP.
- It is expected that matching funds for support of the applicant's travel from another source(s) will also be committed. In cases where matching funds are not available, a written justification of why the matching funds cannot be committed should be provided by the student's or postdoc's mentor.
- The total amount of funds required by an applicant to attend the annual AAVP meeting in a single year will be matched by the AAVP up to a maximum of \$500.00.
- An estimate of the total cost of travel to and from the AAVP meeting must be provided.
- The total number of awards each year will depend on the availability of funds, number of applicants, and location of the meeting.
- The completed Young Investigator Travel Grant Application Form should be obtained and submitted via the Annual Meeting web site.
